Topographische, baugeschichtliche und wirtschaftsgeschichtliche Untersuchungen zu den italienischen Niederlassungen in Konstantinopel vor 1204", das seit 2005 von der Henkelstiftung unterstützt wird, soll nun im Zusammenwirken mit dem DAI (das schon in einer frühen Phase Träger des Projekts war) zu Ende geführt werden. Die Darstellung beruht in erster Linie auf einer Edition, Übersetzung und Kommentierung der lateinischen und griechischen Dokumente in den Staatsarchiven Pisa und Genua, sowie zu einem geringen Teil in Venedig, begleitet von Survey-Forschungen in Istanbul, die nun dank einer elektronischen Kartographierung der Stadt sehr erleichtert werden. Der Bearbeiter glaubt mit großer Sicherheit annehmen zu können, daß der den Genuesen geschenkte, einst der Botaneiates-Familie gehörende Palast identisch ist mit den byzantinischen Substruktionen im Acimusluk sokagi (Müller-Wiener, Bildlexikon S. 541).
